Multiple Winners Take Victory Lane on Thunder Alley Asphalt

Caprara's Thunder Alley Speed Park kicked off their 2010 season on Saturday, April 26, 2010 with full fendered racing action. In racing action were the Men's and Women's Truck divisions, Thunder Cars, Sports Compacts, Super Stocks, Thunder Stocks along with an Enduro.

The Men's truck division kicked off the nights racing action with Greg Rose taking the feature win in the 12 lap feature event. Randy Mooney and Greg Rose would lead the field to the green with Rose taking the early lead. The inside groove seemed to fit most drivers racing styles as the pack headed out of turn four to complete the first lap. David Carlisle would move to the inside of Mooney to take over the second position while Rose would extend his lead on the field. Carlisle would then bobble in the first and second turn as the laps closed which allowed Randy Mooney and Matt Larrive to take over the second and third positions while Rose sailed on to the win.

Mike Ramos and Ike Stone would lead the Super Stocks to green in their 20 lap feature event. Ramos would jump out to the early lead. The first yellow would fly on lap three when Jason Dinzler would spin in turn number three. Dennis Petrus would work through the back of the pack and slip high around Rick Marshall for the second position. Jason Dinzler would look high around Rick Mashall in hopes of obtaining the fourth position but he was unable to do so. Dinzler would even attempt again on a restart but would not be able to complete the move. Ramos would go on to collect the win over Dennis Petrus and Rick Marshall.

Jeff Trapp and Chuck Monica would lead the Thunder Cars to the green in their 15 lap feature event. Trapp would lead the field while coming across for the start, Chuck Monica and JR Durham would spin out. Zak Petrie would climb his way through the pack as the first two cars would battle for position. Craig McGhee would slip into the fourth position while Chuck Monica would round out the top five. Craig McGhee would slip into the third position as he would work under Dan way for position. Chuck Monica would simply follow McGhee to take over the fourth spot. Jeff Trapp would go on to collect the win over Craig McGhee and Chuck Monica.

Tyler Brother and Donny Scovili would lead the Enduro to their 25 lap feature event. Mike Durham would jump out from his fifth place starting position to take the green flag over Bryan Moffatt and Zak Petrie. Bill Devito would slip under Robert Berger to take over the fourth position while Zak Petrie would climb into the lead. Mike Durham would spin out in turn numbers three and four, which would send him pit side. When the checkered flag fell, Zak Petrie would collect the win over Bryan Moffatt and Bill Devito.

Scott Shafer would collect the win in the 12 lap Sports Compact feature event. Shafer who would start on the pole would jump out to the early command. Tim Dunn would quickly fall behind him as the two would keep in close visions of each other as the wheeled around the speedway. Dunn would make numerous attempts to get past Shafer but would be unable to do so as Shafer would come out on top over Dunn, Nate Plantz and Nick Stokes.

Nichole Rombough would take the feature win in the Women's Truck division. Rombough would start on the pole with Brittany Schroy on the outside. Rombough would take the lead and sail on to take the win while Jenn Burnash would slip to the outside of Schroy to finish in the second position and Schroy would complete the top three.

Mike Durham and Homer Dobransky would fill up the Thunder Stock Feature. Durham would go on to take the victory over Dobransky.

Thunder Alley will continue racing action on Saturday, May 1, 2010. In racing action will be all regular divisions plus the open wheel division.
