Mike Ramos rode the outside of the speedway and by lap two had taking control of the field. Dennis Petrus quickly made his way through the pack moved high over Randy Brunelle for the fourth position. Dan Way moved under Randy Bowman to take over the second position. John Williams moved up and around Jeff Trapp to take the fifth position. Day Way closed in on Mike Blair as the two ran around the track nose to tail. Jeff Trapp then moved back under John Williams for the fifth position. As the battled ran tight, Mike Blair collected the win over Dan Way and Billy Matteson.

Chris Randall and Randy Mooney led the field to the green flag in the Men's truck division. Greg Roes who started in the fourth position quickly took the lead of the field. Greg Roes rode the high side of the speedway and quickly moved into the second position. Joe Bourgis, who made his first appearance

at Thunder Alley this season, moved high around Greg Roes and took control of the second position. Luke Roes kept a steady lead and went on to collect his first ever win over Joe Bourgis and Greg Roes.

White, who started in the third position, kept control until Ricky Swem moved high around him for the lead on the field. Dalton Rombough wasted very little time as he moved high around White for the lead. Rombough entered lap traffic and maneuvered quickly through them as he traveled around the speedway. Zak Petrie moved high around Ricky Swem along with Jack White for the second position. Jack White then moved under Homer Dobransky for position. As the checkered dropped, Dalton Rombough collected the win over Jack White and Homer Dobransky.

Jenn Burnash and Nichole Rombough led the women's truck division to the green. Brittany Schroy moved around Nichole Rombough for the lead. Jenn Burnash then moved up to the high side and to the second position from Rombough. Jenn Burnash closed in on Brittany Schroy for the lead. Brittany Schroy held off challenges for Jenn Burnash for the win over Nichole Rombough.
