**Roes, Woodworth, Schafer, Ramos, Swem, and Burnash Take Thunder Alley Wins**

In racing action were all regular divisions which include the men's and women's trucks, thunder stocks, thunder cars, super stocks, and sports compacts. While Mother Nature played an issue throughout the night, a complete show was completed.

The men's truck division kicked off the night with Matt Larrive and Randy Mooney leading the field to the green. Greg Rose who started in the sixth position, quickly moved to the outside and filled out the third position as the field completed lap one. Matt Larrive controlled the field as Greg Rose made a move to the outside of Randy Mooney for position number two. Continuing to ride the outside Roes was the head of the field by lap four. Travis Edwards moved under Randy Mooney for the third position. Mooney would then kiss the front stretch wall coming out of turn number four and slows on the speedway. Keith Doxtater and Jim Siegel led the Super Stock division to the green flag with Doxtater taking the control of the field. Ike Stone who started in the fourth position took control of the field while Rick Marshall moved under Keith Doxater for fifth. Mike Ramos slid under Jim Siegel for the fourth position as Dennis Petrus ventured to the high side of the speedway and battled for the seventh position with George Kiskiel. George Kiskiel and Dennis Petrus slid under Rick Marshall for the fifth and sixth position. Mike Ramos took over the second position coming out of turn number two as Ramos then moved high for the lead. Mike Ramos collected the win over Ike Stone and Dennis Petrus.

Dan Swem and Joel Hall led the Thunder Stock division to their green as Dan Swem took the lead over Ricky Swem and Joel Hall. Dalton Rombough moved high around Travis Wicks for the fourth position. Dalton Rombough then moved under Joel Hall for third. Ricky Swem moved high around Dan Swem for the lead. Dalton Rombough kept his momentum going high around the speedway as he pulled around Ricky Swem for the second position. Travis Wicks and Brock Stevens moved around Joel Hall for the fourth and fifth positions. Ricky Swem held off a last minute charge from Dalton Rombough to take the win with Dan Swem collecting third.

Randy Bowman and Don Woodworth led the Thunder Cars to the green in their 15 lap feature. Don Woodworth led the field early over Jeff Trapp and Chuck Monica. Chuck Monica moved under Jeff Trapp for the second position as Billy Matteson moved high around Mike Blair

for the sixth position. Billy Matteson moved high around Dan Way in turns three and four for the fifth position. Kathy Dafoe moved under Jeff Trapp for fourth. Don Woodworth continues to lead the way. Kathy Dafoe pulls to the outside and completes a pass over Jeff Trapp. Dafoe then moves over Chuck Monica for second but as she checked, Dafoe would fall back. Don Woodworth collected the win over Chuck Monica and Jeff Trapp.

Tim Dunn and Nate Plantz led the Sports Compacts to green. Tim Dunn took initial control. Scott Schafer moved high around Nate Plantz for the second position. Scott Schafer and Nate Plantz then moved under Tim Dunn coming out of turn number two to take the lead. While the field ran tightly together, Scott Schafer collected the win over Nate Plantz and Tim Dunn.

Lyndsay Wendell and Jenn Burnash led the Women's trucks to the green flag with Jenn Burnash taking the lead. On lap four, Brittany Schroy took her truck pitside. Jenn Burnash was able to hold off for the win over Lyndsay Wendell and Nichole Rombough.

Thunder Alley Speed Park will continue racing on Saturday, July 31, 2010. Headlining the evening will be the open wheel division. Joining them will be all regular divisions.
