**Chuck Hebing Wins Patriot Event at Thunder Alley

The ASCS Patriot Sprint Cars headlined the racing action at Thunder Alley Speed Park on Friday June 2nd along with the purestocks, streetstocks, and thundercar divisions. Chuck Hebing and Bryan Howland led the field of 19 cars to Matt Burdick's green flag in the 25 lap feature event. Chuck Hebing took the quick lead on the field with Bryan Howland filling into second. Ricky Wilson moved quickly through the field as he picked through five positions in one lap putting him self into the top ten. Justin Barger moved under Bryan Howland to take over the second position. Bobby Breen moved high around John Karklin Jr to take over the sixth position while Ricky Wilson put his number 42w in the top five. Ricky Wilson moved under Jared Zimbardi to take over the fourth position. As the checkered flag flew on the speedway, Chuck Hebing would pick up his first Thunder Alley win in the ASCS Patriot Sprints.

In the street stock division, Dave Fetterly and Al Doxtater led the field to green with Fetterly taking the early lead on the field. Dave Pope quickly moved from the third position into the lead while Dave Fetterly and Phillip Walker rounded out the top three. Phillip Walker moved under Al Doxtater to take over the second position. As the checkered flag flew, Dave Pope would pick up the win.

In the purestock division, Mike Lampson and Bill Youngs led the field to green with Bill Youngs taking the early lead. Mike Durham filled up the second position while Kevin Smith, Scott Lampson, and Verne Harris filled out the top five. As the checkered flag flew, Bill Youngs would pick up the win.

In the four cylinder domestic feature, David Blair Jr. and Dave Travis led the field to the green while David Blair quickly took command on the field. Robert Scott moved quickly through the field and moved to the outside of David Blair Jr. to take away the top spot. Chuck Monica, Mike Trapp, Dan Ashley and David Blair Jr. filled out the rest of the top five. Mike Trapp moved under Chuck Monica to take the second position, while David Blair Jr. moved around Dan Ashley to take over fourth. Mike Trapp moved under Robert Scott to take over the lead on the field, but Robert Scott fought back as he moved around the outside of Mike Trapp to

take the lead back. Mike Trapp wasted no time as he quickly took the lead and the checkered flag. Robert Scott and Chuck Monica rounded out the top three.

Mike Blair and Mike Durham led the field to green in the 4 cylinder Foreign and Truck feature with Mike Blair taking the lead but the lead was short lived as Mike Durham took over the top spot. Nelson Bice filled up the second position while Mike Blair, Michael Stewart and Kris Bice rounded out the top five. Nelson Bice quickly used the outside to put his car at the front of the field while Michael Stewart looked to take over the second position from Mike Durham. Nelson Bice would go on to pick up the checkers with Mike Durham and Kris Bice rounding out the top three.

Thunder Alley Speed Park will resume racing on June 8 with Family Autograph Night at the Speedway. In action on this night will be the DIRTcar Modifieds racing for \$1,500 to win, along with the purestocks, streetstocks, mod lites and thunder car divisions.
